

Questions to Ponder – Daniel 4 – Humbleness

Read Daniel 4:4-5 – Bad Dream

1. When is the last time you had a bad dream? Do you think it meant something?
2. What do you consider the most important thing in life?

Read Daniel 4:1-18 – Nebuchadnezzar’s Dream

3. Do you ever see life as a competition? Are you winning?

Read Daniel 4:19-27 – Daniel Interprets the Dream

4. Look carefully at Daniel’s advice in verse 27. What would change (if anything) in your life if you took Daniel’s advice?

“This is a change you have to implement in your life every day. Every day, you will want to get something for yourself. And every day, you have to decide not to make life about you and to make it about somebody else.”

5. Do you find Daniel’s advice difficult to take? Why or why not?

Read Daniel 4:28-33 – The Dream is Fulfilled

6. Do you know anyone who has “lost it” because they wouldn’t let go of something? (Control, stuff, drugs, abusive relationships, ...) Could you see “the fall” coming?
7. Have you ever had to “lose it” to learn how to be humble?

Read Daniel 4:34-37 – The King is Restored

8. God gives good gifts. If you’ve ever “lost it,” what did God give you in return?
